Children's Ministry Behavior Guidelines (Revised 2/6/18)

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- 1) Children are expected to comply with all instructions given by any adult children's ministry staff member.
 - 2) Children are to respect church facilities and vehicles. Should a child's actions cause damage or breakage, he/she will be held responsible for repair or replacement of the broken or damaged item.
 - 3) When attending any church program or event, all children are expected to participate in those activities, not hang around outside the church building, roam the hallways, etc.
 - 4) When participating in any church activity, all children are expected to be present for the entirety of the event. Unless special arrangements have been made ahead of time between the children's minister and that child's parents, no student can leave early.
 - 5) When we return from an activity, we ask that parents pick up their children at the time stated. We try very hard both to accurately pinpoint our return times and to notify parents from the road on those rare occasions when we do experience major delays; we ask that parents be here to meet us when we arrive, rather than waiting at home for a phone call from their young person.
 - 6) Upon our return from any road trip, children are expected to help clean out the interior of the church vehicle(s) before claiming their luggage and going home.
 - 7) Cell phones will be collected and/or put up during children's events and activities.
 - 8) This should go without saying, but for the record, foul language, uncooperative attitudes, and intentional exclusion will not be permitted to be a part of any Central United Methodist Church children's function.
 - 9) The rule of thumb we're aiming for: ". . . whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father" (Colossians 3:17). If you can't do it in the name of Jesus, you don't need to do it at all.
 - 10) The children's ministry staff and volunteers of Central United Methodist Church reserve the right to dismiss or suspend from any activity any child who demonstrates an attitude of indifference to these guidelines. If the violation occurs during an out-of-town event, dismissal may include sending the child home at the expense of his/her parent(s)/guardian(s).

We have read these guidelines. We agree to abide by them, and understand the consequences of not following them.
