- Response: A SCOUT IS LOYAL**
- Boy Scout: There will always be some in the land who are poor. That is why I am commanding you to share freely with the poor and with other Israelites in need. (Deuteronomy 15:11)
- Response: A SCOUT IS HELPFUL**
- Cub Scout: Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other. (Romans 12:10)
How wonderful and pleasant it is when brothers live together in harmony! (Psalm 133)
- Response: A SCOUT IS FRIENDLY**
- Girl Scout: Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them. (Ephesians 4:29)

- Boy Scout: The godly care for their animals, but the wicked are always cruel. (Proverbs 12:10)
- Response: A SCOUT IS KIND**
- Cub Scout: Obey your spiritual leaders, and do what they say. Their work is to watch over your souls, and they are accountable to God. Give them reason to do this with joy and not with sorrow. That would certainly not be for your benefit. (Hebrews 13:17)
