Out of devotion to his sister and family, Tripp Mabry held this scholarship very dear to his heart and because of him this scholarship has lived on. - Requirements are:
- 1) Must be a member of Central United Methodist Church and a current high school senior or full-time student in good standing at an accredited college/university leading to a full range of baccalaureate or advanced degree.
 - 2) Hold an overall GPA indicative of intelligence and interest in further education.
 - 3) Exemplifies a sound moral and well rounded character through participation in extracurricular and church related activities, evidenced by qualities such as truthfulness, devotion to responsibilities, compassion, leadership and concern for others.
 - 4) Involvement in community service, whether through the church, student's school or independent volunteering.
 - 5) Demonstrates financial need.

 - 4) Must be of sound moral character
